

## BACKGROUND

The Portuguese Navy Tall Ship *Sagres* will be carrying out a Circumnavigation tour in 2020. This mission is part of the Celebration Programme for the Fifth Centenary of Fernão de Magalhães Circumnavigation.

## NAVIGATION PLANNING

The voyage planning recreates the Circumnavigation commanded by the Portuguese navigator Fernão de Magalhães (2019-2022) and includes:

- Presence in Tokyo 2020 during the Olympic Games;
- Participation in the celebrations of the 500 years of the Discovery of the Strait of Magellan in Punta Arenas, Chile, in October 18<sup>th</sup>-23<sup>th</sup>, 2020;
- Navigation in company of ESPS *Juan Sebastian Elcano* during part of the voyage;
- Presence in cities of the Global Network of Magellan Cities;
- Presence in cities of the Portuguese diaspora.

During 371 days, the ship's mission will focus on sea training for first and second-year Naval Academy cadets, as well as, on port calls and economic diplomacy activities.
